

1 Registrations

1.1 NetSetGo

Players registering in NetSetGo may register as individuals and shall be placed in teams at the discretion of the Registrar. Individual players may make a request, in writing, that they be placed with particular players. All requests will be determined by the Registrar at their discretion.

Players may form their own NetSetGo team provided that the team:

- has a minimum of eight (8) players;
- complies with the age restrictions identified in BHSNA Registration Policy; and
- where possible, supplies a qualified coach who is approved by the Coaching Coordinator.

All NetSetGo teams will be capped at a maximum of nine (9) players. If there is an insufficient number of registered players to form a team the Club may:

- liaise with the community and other clubs within BHSNA to find additional players; and
- request individual players to play up an age group.

If the Club is unable to place a player/s in a team, the Club will endeavour to find another BHSNA club with availability and transfer that player/s registration to that club. If a player cannot be transferred to another BHSNA club, the Club may require that player to deregister.

1.2 Junior Teams (U10s-U14s)

Players registering into Junior age groups should register as individuals and shall be graded into teams in accordance with the Club's Grading Policy.

All Junior Teams will be capped at a maximum of nine (9) players. If there is an insufficient number of registered players to form a team the Club may:

- liaise with the community and other clubs within BHSNA to find additional players; and
- request individual players to play up an age group.

If the Club is unable to place a player/s in a team, the Club will endeavour to find another BHSNA club with availability and transfer that player/s registration to that club. If a player cannot be transferred to another BHSNA club, the Club may require that player to deregister.

Individual players may make a written request to be placed with particular players if there are extenuating circumstances. Written requests must be made by all players involved. All requests will be determined by the Registrar at their discretion. If a request is approved all players will be placed in the team of the lowest graded player.

1.3 Intermediate, Reserve and Open Teams

Players registering into Intermediate, Reserve or Open age groups are to form their own team. These teams will be formed independently of the Club's grading system.

The team must:

- nominate a manager/coach as the point of communication for the team;
- supply one (1) suitable umpire approved by the Senior Umpiring Convenor;
- notify the Club of their nominated grade; and
- notify the Club of their intended training time (if any).

Individual players may contact the Registrar and/or Assistant Registrar requesting to be placed in a suitable team. Individual placements will be made in consultation with the team contact person, subject to vacancies within a registered team.

If the Club is unable to place a player/s in a team, the Club will endeavour to find another BHSNA club with availability and transfer that player/s registration to that club. If a player cannot be transferred to another BHSNA club, the Club may require that player to deregister.

2 Late Registrations

Late registrations will be allowed at the discretion of the Club Executive. Players will be placed in a team in accordance with the Club's grading and registration policies.

3 Transfers

Players who wish to transfer to another club within BHNSA must do so before the Club's grading day.

4 De-Registration

Players who wish to de-register may receive a part refund of their registration fees paid, subject to the following:

- the BHSNA component of the fee will be refunded in accordance with the BHSNA Registration Policy;
- the Netball NSW fee is <u>not refundable</u> this fee is for a twelve-month period and is only required to be paid once a year regardless of which club or association is joined; and
- the Club component of the fee will be refunded at the discretion of the Club Executive.

Active Kids Vouchers are <u>not refundable</u>. However, they can be transferred to another registered provider. This amount will be deducted from the applicable refund.

Once a player is de-registered under the BHSNA Registration Policy, they cannot reregister with any other BHSNA club in the same season

5 Player and Parent Acknowledgment

By registering with the Club all players and parents acknowledge that:

- players are required to attend all mandatory training sessions and competition games;
- if players are unavailable due to sickness or unavoidable circumstances, they
 are required to advise their team coach or manager as soon as possible, and
 where possible provide advance notice;
- players must be in full Club uniform for all competition matches; and

 they will comply with the Club Constitution, the By-Laws, any policies and procedures of the Club, BHSNA and/or Netball NSW, including the Netball NSW Code of Behaviour Policy, for the time being in force.
